Re-Intervention in the Aesthetic Zone: Managing: Aesthetic Failures.



Dr. Pariente earned his DDS degree from the University of Paris René Descartes, in 2009. He enrolled at New York University College of Dentistry in the Advanced Program for International Dentists in Implant Dentistry (graduated 2012). After returning to Paris, his private practice is limited to Implantology and Periodontology. He co-authored several international and national publications on implant dentistry.

With the exponential rise in implant placements, re-intervention has evolved from a rare occurrence to a routine clinical challenge. Mechanical complications, biological failures (such as mucositis and peri-implantitis), and patient dissatisfaction—whether functional or aesthetic—are now common indications for prosthetic revision. In certain cases, the three-dimensional mispositioning of the implant may even necessitate its removal. This lecture will explore the clinical decision-making process when facing a failing or compromised restoration in the aesthetic zone.
